Food Pantry For 2019 we will rotate our donations between Newark Neighbours and Westview Christian Fellowship. For January we have focused on the needs of **Newark Neighbours**. They were in need toiletries (shampoos, tooth paste, soap), paper products (Kleenex, toilet paper) and cleaning supplies (paper towel, window cleaner, multipurpose cleaner). For February our focus will be **Westview Christian Fellowship**. Currently, they are in need of pantry items, hygiene items, bus tickets and cleaning products.

We have two bins set up in the foyer to collect donations. Beige is for food items, blue is for toiletries and cleaning products.

A supply of pantry items is kept in our church pantry room for anyone who is experiencing a time of need. Of late we have not had people from the community, but we never know when a need may arise. The church office has a "Practical Assistance" program that is in place for any requests from within our church or from those in our community.

The pantry has an open-door policy, if you need assistance please help yourself. We want to respect the privacy of our members and friends and will never ask who is using the pantry.

Please remember items donated must not have expired and be in new condition for them to be donated. In the past month a garbage bag of food items had to be disposed of, as they were past their expiry dates. Food banks are not allowed to give out food items that are past their printed expiry dates.

We have received lovely thank you notes, which are posted on the bulletin board in the foyer. Both organizations are thankful for the support they receive from NUMC each month.
