## "Pastor of Youth and Young Adult Ministries" Search Committee Update

**TO REVIEW:** A motion was presented at the Tuesday June 12, 2018 membership meeting that the search for an associate pastor for the youth begin as soon as possible.

The Search Committee for the Lead Pastor was asked if it would be interested in taking on this search as well. After careful discussion and thought, all members of the Committee agreed that this was a good idea since we were already familiar with what was involved in the search process.

A pastoral profile was prepared and the position title changed from Pastor of Relational Ministries to its current title of "Pastor of Youth and Young Adult Ministries". The position was posted on the church and MCEC websites by mid July. Ads were worked out and placed in the Canadian Mennonite.

**UPDATE:** For some weeks now, the Search Committee has been focusing on an MLI or application for this position. With the candidating events for a Lead Pastor completed, we were ready to more fully devote our attention to this MLI.

An informal meet & greet was held with this potential candidate last week and we are currently discussing next steps. At this point, we don't yet know where this will lead us and we ask for your prayers and support in our further discerning.
