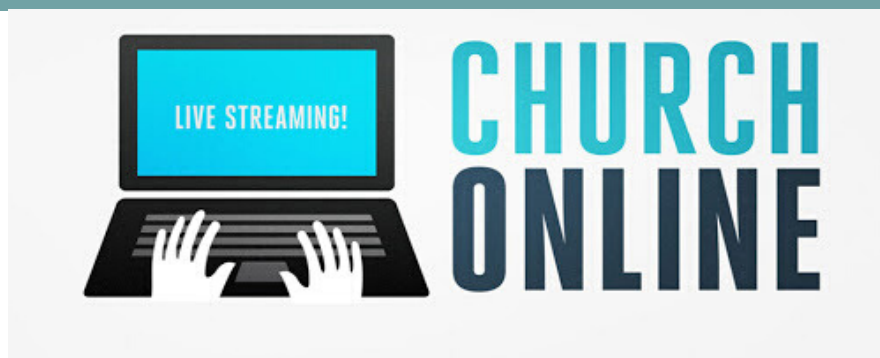


## **Welcome Back Renate**

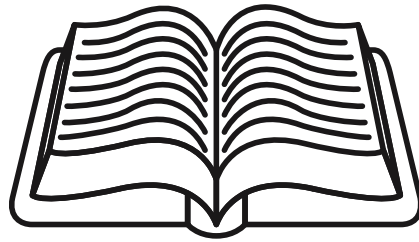
## God's Story, God's Song
