NUMC REOPENING

NUMC Phase 1 Guidelines for Reopening

Over the last few weeks plans for reopening the church have been discussed and we have a NUMC Phase 1 reopening guidelines ready to present to the congregation. As we feel more comfortable we will move to Phase 2 and Phase 3. Click **Guidelines** to be redirected to the church website.

Indoor Worship Services / Funerals Pre-Register Attendance

We will be asking everyone who plans to attend a worship service or funeral, to preregister. This is done through the REALM system that those with emails were asked to set up your accounts. Alternatively, you can phone the church office and we will add you to the registration list.

Volunteer Training

In order to begin having indoor worship services and funerals, we need to have our volunteer teams trained in the new procedures for entering and exiting the building. In addition we will be training the volunteer teams on appropriate health and safety measures that are in place to ensure everyone is safe.

The training dates are Sept. 2 @ 11 am, Sept. 3 @ 7 pm, Sept. 8 @ 11 am or Sept. 8 @ 7 pm Let the church office know which time is best for you. You only need to attend at one session.

Volunteers Needed

We are in need of a lot more volunteers for each service in order to safely enter, contact trace, seat and exit the building. Each service requires 2 AV attendants, 6 ushers and 4 Welcome Hosts. At this time, we have just enough volunteers for one worship service. That means this group will be on for every worship service. That is simply not possible.

For funerals we require the same number of volunteers and currently have 2 AV attendants and 2 ushers. That is simply not enough.

So we are putting out an all call request to the congregation. We need your help. If you are able to assist by being a greeter, welcome host, elevator attendant, seating usher or donation usher, please speak with the church office. Come to the training session, see the safety precautions we have in place and then make a final decision.

ONLINE & TEXT GIVING

We now have online giving and text giving.. Previously, online giving was done through Canada Helps, it is now done direct through our REALM system.

GIVING FUNDS

There are 5 funds you can opt to give to. Budget, Capital Fund, MCC, Christian Witness and Friends of Mennonite Centre Ukraine. Budget and Capital Fund, have a memo section, in this area you can say be more specific of where to allocate the funds, i.e. Budget - library or Deacons. Capital Fund - Roof or Renovations.

Tax Receipts and Fees

- there is a 3% processing fee to us to use these methods of donating.
- during the checkout process you can opt to cover this cost
- Example \$10.00 donation + \$0.30 processing fee = \$10.30 donation, donor receives tax receipt for \$10.30
- Tax Receipts for donations will be issued at the end of the calendar year
- VANCO will send you a receipt of donation as proof that the transaction has been processed.
