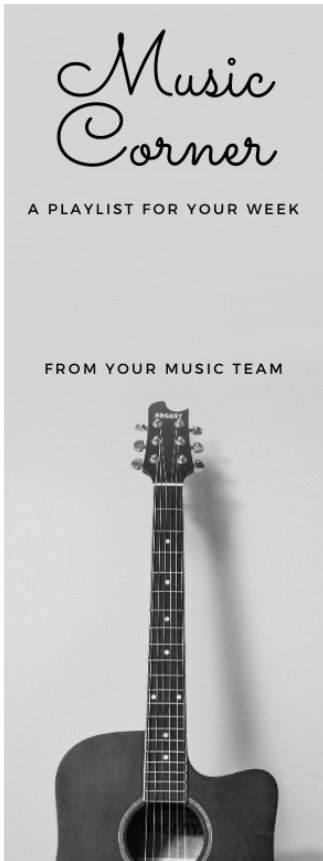

# ONLINE & TEXT GIVING

We now have online giving and text giving. Previously, online giving was done through Canada Helps, it is now done direct through our REALM system.

## **TEXT GIVING**

Text **NUMCGIVE** to **73256** then follow the steps.

- recommended using all CAPS as this shuts off the auto-correct feature on the phone. Less likely to make a typo

## **GIVING FUNDS**

There are 5 funds you can opt to give to. Budget, Capital Fund, MCC, Christian Witness and Friends of Mennonite Centre Ukraine.

Budget and Capital Fund, have a memo section, in this area you can say be more specific of where to allocate the funds, i.e. Budget - library or Deacons. Capital Fund - Roof or Renovations.

## **Tax Receipts and Fees**

- there is a 3% processing fee to us to use these methods of donating.
- during the checkout process you can opt to cover this cost
- Example \$10.00 donation + \$0.30 processing fee = \$10.30 donation, donor receives tax receipt for \$10.30
- Tax Receipts for donations will be issued at the end of the calendar year
- VANCO will send you a receipt of donation as proof that the transaction has been processed.

Contact the church office if you have questions on how to use these options or if you have questions on how to allocate your donation.

We continue to welcome donations by cheque or E-Transfers if that is your preferred method of donating.
