As we reach Thanksgiving weekend, I cannot believe all that the last 6 weeks have held for our family. Summer ended, and with that, my maternity leave. I returned to work as a supply teacher, and then picked up a year-long quarter time position in a grade I classroom. We bought a new house unexpectedly, and then went through the whirlwind of getting our own home listed and sold. Sunday school was overhauled and launched with a new look and a new name to reflect this new season - we're now called Red Brick Kids!

In short, the three main pieces of my life - work, church, and home - have been in a state of upheaval. My mom uses an analogy for these seasons of change. It's a visual of a chicken strutting along the top of a piano to the beat of the song being played. As soon as the beat is changed the chicken falls out of rhythm and has to scurry to get back on beat. It eventually falls into the new beat, but there are a few moments of panic - maybe even some feathers flying - as the chicken tries to gain new footing. The analogy sounds silly, but I haven't been able to come up with a better one for this season. I feel like I'm a bit panicky, losing a few proverbial feathers of my own.

This playlist reflects the feelings of this season. There is a line in the song by Craig Cardiff that says, nothing worth having's ever easy, and the pain is only a sign. Those words have kept me going as I've struggled through these days of figuring out how to teach and how to navigate changes to Sunday School and how to buy and sell a house and all the emotions that come with that. If ever there was a time to be reminded of all that there is to be thankful, it is now. Because ultimately, all of these changes are for the good. God has been faithful, and will continue to be, and for that, I am so grateful. Happy Thanksgiving!
