For about 1400 years, people have expressed a longing and found strength and comfort in the hymn "O come, O come, Emmanuel." Here's a beautiful rendition by the Piano Guys to lead us into the Advent season.

In many North American Mennonite traditions, "Nun ist sie erschienen (The heavenly sun now has risen) is sung every Christmas season, even in churches that date back to the 1870's, and where German hasn't been used in a long time. Will Friesen was surprised that this song did not hold a particularly prominent place in our Christmas hymn repertoire. Tabor choir, Will's alma mater, sings a beautiful arrangement by Larry Nickel.

What would this Advent/Christmas season be without Händel's Messiah, the story of Jesus' life from birth to death to resurrection? An Australian choir in Sydney delights us with the best performance ever. The choir of hundreds of voices sings with the energy, enthusiasm, conviction, and precision of a college choir. Amazing!!!




Advent Monologue


