FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR FOR WORSHIP:

Since the pandemic lockdowns, it has become increasingly clear that the right time has come to bring the German worship services to an end. Taking into consideration factors that I will lay out in more detail in my annual report, the leadership group for the German worship ministry together decided to conclude the biweekly German services at the end of 2023. We look forward to planning an event toward the end of the year, involving the entire congregation, to celebrate and give God thanks for 85 years of worship ministry in the language of our founders here at NUMC.

Related to this decision and other factors in my personal life, I have decided to finish covering Rachael's worship coordinator position during her maternity leave to the end of summer, guide the German worship ministry to its closing at end of December, and then retire from professional pastoral ministry. My husband Randy & I intend to make NUMC our church home together, and we look forward to participating in the life of this faith community in a lay capacity in the future.

I invite your prayers for the both of us, for the German leadership team, and for the people who are still finding their worship home in the German services, as we navigate toward these changes. I believe there is recognition on all sides that endings can be good and healthy, even if they are not always easy; but we all belong to each other, and it is my hope & prayer that together we can move forward in a way that leaves no one behind — because the language of God's grace & love is universal.

2022 Financial Update (draft)...
