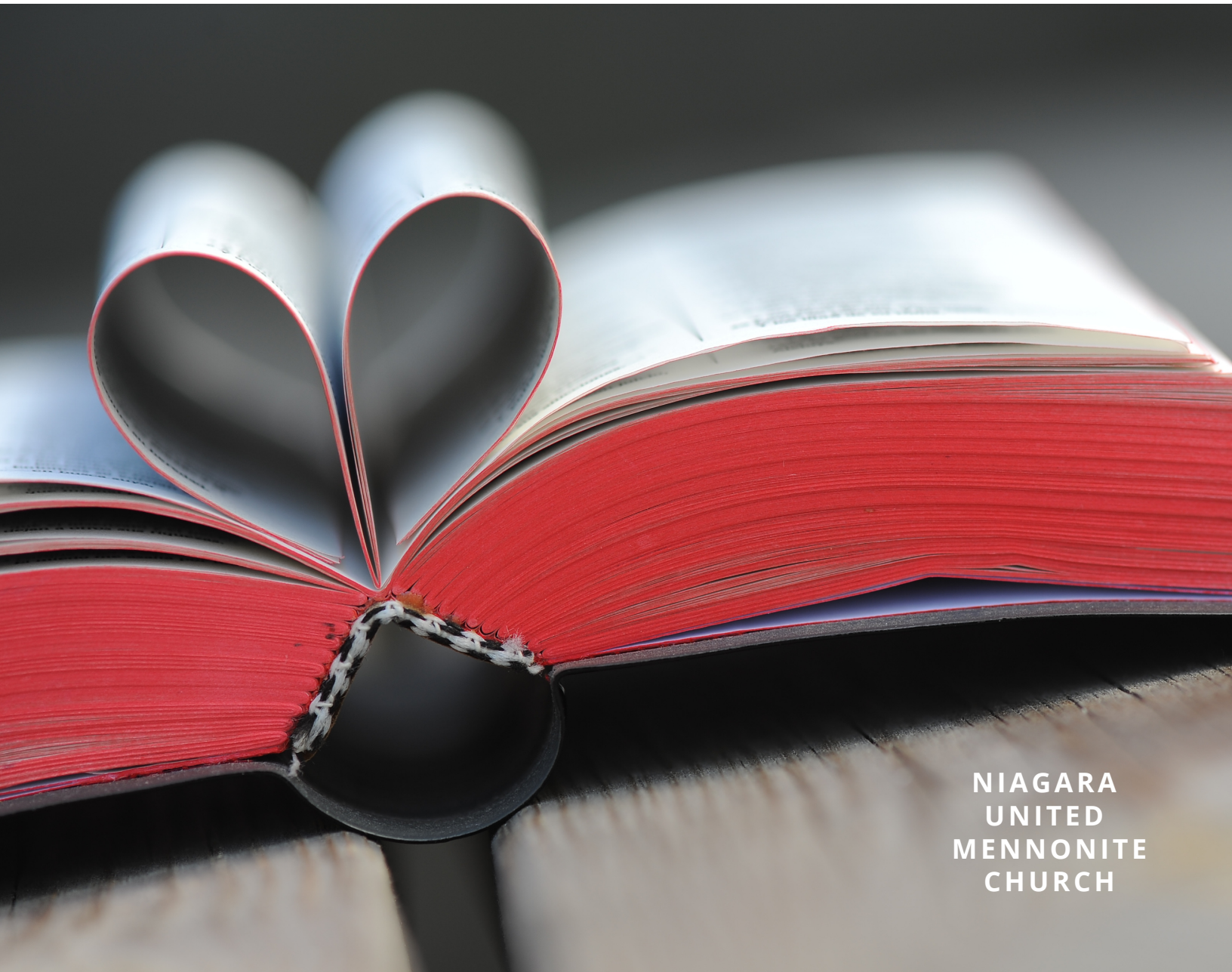


Prayer Time
