AGM Summary

On behalf of the Church Board, thank you to all who attended and helped to make our AGM a success on Tuesday Feb. 21. The active participation of the membership is important as we continue to worship together and offer our programs and activities in the community.

Financial Update

On February 21, 2023, at the Annual General Meeting, the church membership approved a 2023 expense budget of \$463,375. In order to continue and support all of our church programs, from Sunday morning Worship Services, Youth and Young Adult Programs, Red Brick Kids, caregiving, outside ministry, and many more activities, we require weekly donations/receipts of \$8,911 in order to meet these expense obligations.

For the first seven Sundays of 2023 we have received at total of \$30,315 or \$4,331 per week. We ask that our church family continue to pray for and support our ongoing financial obligations.

Anatomy of Our Revived Church

At the AGM on Tuesday Evening, the church membership reviewed and passed the following motion:

"We, the members of Niagara United Mennonite Church commit to the new proposed course of action and to begin the challenging and joyous work of exploring our faith and practices in a new way, including reaching out in new ways into the community that God has placed us in."

This means that we will be re-focusing our efforts from internal facing programs to external facing efforts designed to develop relationships with our neighbours. This refocusing will take much prayer in order to ensure we are following the direction of the Holy Spirit. More updates on this new focus will be announced in the coming weeks and months. We ask that pray for this congregation, for our community, and for the Holy Spirit to prepare the way for us as we watch what God has in store for us. As it says in 1 Thessalonians 5:17, pray without ceasing. The Church Board thanks the congregation for their vote of support for this new direction.
