And the icing on the cake, or the tomato on the burger, was a sharing by Ly Vang of her personal experience in Thailand as a child of receiving a school kit in the refugee camp where she was staying with her family. This gift proved to be a changing moment for her in her life, and all of us felt how our simple act of packing school kits took on a whole new meaning – God's spirit was at work in our midst.
