## "No one wants to be a refugee"

From Isaiah 21:14-15:

"Bring water for the thirsty ... Meet the fugitive with bread. For they have fled from the swords, from the drawn sword, and from the bent bow, and from the press of battle."

The advantage of sponsoring refugees as a Christian community is that it makes our church visible as a place where servants of Christ put their faith and love into action by welcoming the stranger (Romans 12:13). A personal benefit for members, besides exposure to interesting people from different cultural and religious backgrounds, is that financial contributions towards sponsorship that are made through the church can be receipted for income tax purposes.

Taking a broader view, we are agents of societal and economic change, the effects of which we will only see in hindsight.
