Refugee Sponsorship Update

This past Tuesday a group of NUMC members gathered in our choir room to discuss the possibility of sponsoring a refugee family to come to Canada. The first question we asked was: is NUMC willing and able to undertake such a project at this time? And next: which avenue do we follow to carry out this project? In the past, we have undertaken similar projects on our own by raising sufficient funds, and also providing necessary volunteers to cover needs of the refugees.

A second avenue is now available to us through the Bridge of Hope Community based in Grace Mennonite Church in St. Catharines.

Our group suggestion to the congregation is that we explore the avenue of working through Bridge of Hope as a NUMC refugee sponsorship committee. To this end, we will schedule a congregational meeting, after Easter, in which more definite information about Bridge of Hope will be shared with the congregation, followed by open discussion.

Olive Wood Handmade Hand Cross from Bethlehem!

The Shepherds' Trail (<u>www.theshepherdstrail.com</u>) is a group of Palestinian-Christian artisans working in partnership with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bethlehem to support programs for youth, women, and marginalized communities.

The community makes wholesale olive wood handmade hand crosses (Size: 9.5*4.5*1.2 cm.) individually packed including a bookmark with information about this initiative and ready for resale made by Palestinian artisans in Bethlehem. The crosses come in packages of 25.
