Refugee Concerns Update

A group of 20+ people stayed after church on April 21st to hear Doug Schulz from Grace Mennonite Church explain more about the Bridge of Hope Community and how members of our congregation can be involved in refugee sponsorship. He pointed out that Niagara UM does not need help from BoHC because, based on prior experience, we already have the knowledge and expertise required to conduct a successful refugee sponsorship on our own if we want to do it. However, Bridge of Hope is still in need of volunteers and funding to support two South Sudanese families, one that may be arriving this summer and another whose arrival is expected some time in the next year. The St. Catharines based group, which is made up of an alliance of several churches and two mosques, is open to new participants, whether they formally represent a faith group or not. All are welcome to BoHC's next meeting on Tuesday, June 4 at 6:00 p.m. at Grace Mennonite Church. Coffee and snacks will be served.
