Refugee and Bridge of Hope Update

On Tuesday, June 4, Greta Wiens and I attended the Bridge of Hope Community meeting at Grace Mennonite Church. It was my first visit, but Greta has been an active member for several years. There were 12 people from various churches/ mosques at the meeting. We learned about the refugee families who are in the process of moving from camps in South Sudan to Canada. One family of 5 members is expected to arrive later this year, possibly the Fall. The other family is hoping to arrive some time in 2025. In preparation for the arrival of the family of 5, a house is already available, but all other necessary household furnishings and clothing will be collected once the family is on its way. This will provide an opportunity for us at NUMC to collect and donate suitable household needs. At that time, we will provide more details of supplies and furnishings needed.

In addition to these household needs, BOH is looking for donations from the community. About \$40,000 is still needed to cover the costs of setting up the two families after their arrival in Canada. Our church has set up a Refugee Support Fund to collect money to be donated to Bridge of Hope for this purpose. At present, there is \$550 in our Fund.

Please take the time to pray for these two refugee families from South Sudan that they may soon be allowed to travel to Canada to start a new safe life, and consider donating to the Refugee Fund to support the families when they arrive.
