Bridge of Hope Update

After a nearly four-year wait, Bridge of Hope has been informed that the first of our sponsored families from South Sudan should be arriving in Canada between September 1st and Thanksgiving. As BoH treasurer, I am once again reworking the budget so that we will be in compliance with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada regulations. Our second family has also had their medical exams so we would not be surprised if they follow soon after the first. The two families are not related to each other and are living in two different refugee camps in Uganda. More specific arrival information will be sent as the time gets closer. - Greta
