We are grateful for your faithful generosity and commitment to the ministry of our church. As of October 31, 2025, our giving totals \$231,891 toward our annual budget goal of \$398,600.

We require another \$166,709 in budget giving in the next 2 months to meet these obligations. Thank you to all who have made contributions this year.
